Pastor Hilary will be on vacation from October 11-18. Carol Wyerman will fill the pulpit on October 12.

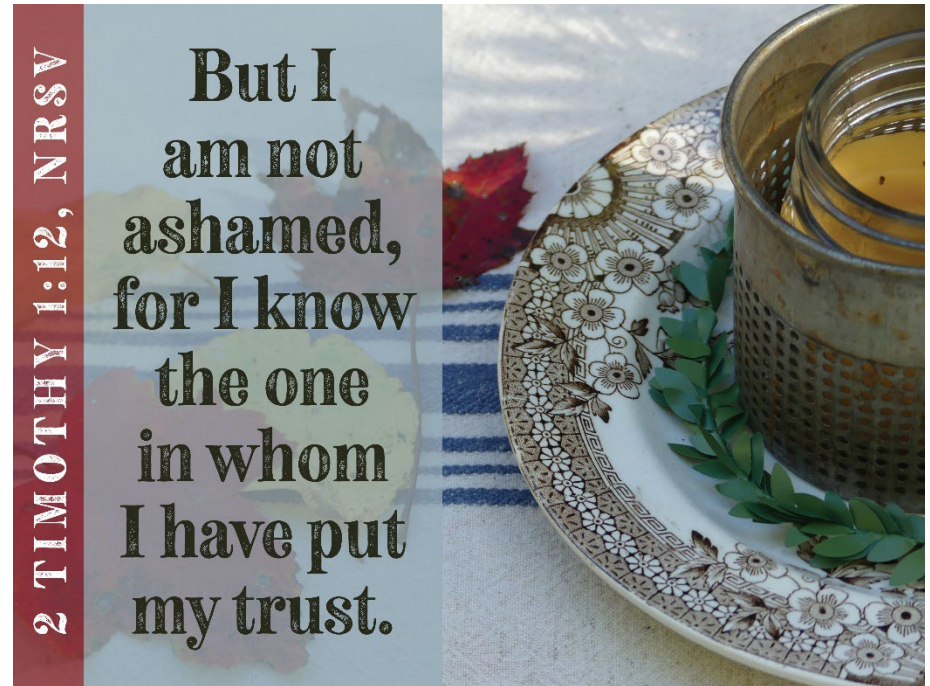
Souper-Cook Off
