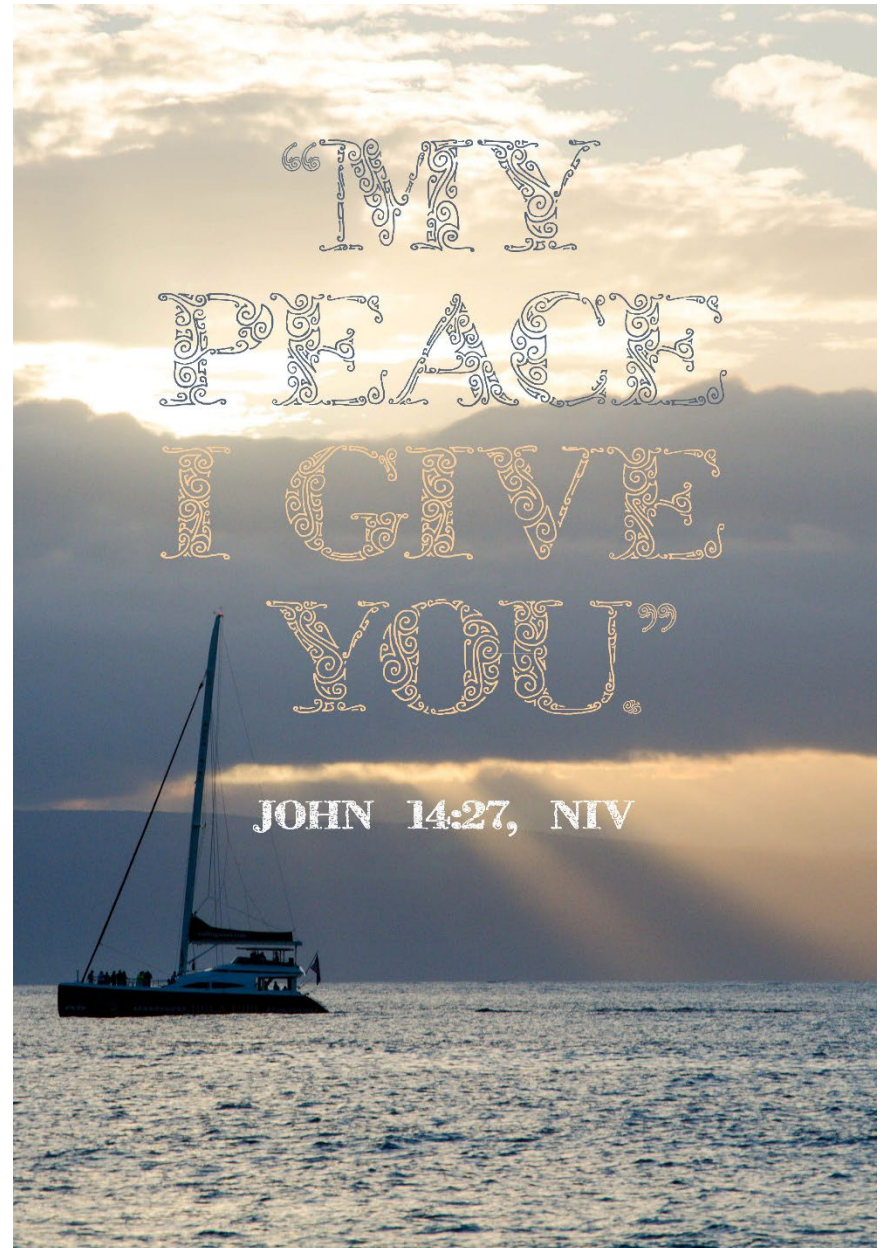
The Per Capita amount for 2026 is \$41 per member.
